RED'S RYE- crimson in color, malted rye with a belgian richness, huge citrus hops, a long spicy finish 4

**J.K. SCRUMPY'S HARD CIDER** (FLUSHING, MICHIGAN): an organic sparkling farmhouse cider from almar orchards, sweet and delicious ~22oz 7

### **MICHIGAN BREWING COMPANY**(WEBBERVILLE):
